# 1. Contact mechanics, pre-reunion business, RSVP notifications, name tags:

The food at the buffet was very good and there was plenty of it. Would have been good if we could have had the cake brought out a little sooner. The personnel were friendly and did a great job serving the food.

Were out of several items when I went through line (last)--I had to "grab" server to try to get more food. Empty plates refilled when everyone else had already gone through the lines.

Okay. Not my choice for a buffet. Food variety seemed disjointed.

To be honest, not great. I expected more from a country club. They cleared the buffet tables way before the designated time to eat was over. I had enough but I think some people didn't even get to eat. It seemed as if they ran out of food.
